Graduation Requirements

Panyaden High School Diploma Credits

The total of 38 credits are to be completed over 4 academic years.

IB Diploma Programme

All students, regardless of their curriculum choice, are expected to complete the Extended Essay, Theory of Knowledge and Creativity, Activity Service.

Thai Language

As a school licensed by the Ministry of Education of Thailand, all Thai students are required to study 4 hours of Thai Language and Culture peer week. Non-Thai students are required to take 50 minutes of Thai Language and Culture per week.

Activities and Athletics

Students at Panyaden International School are provided with ample opportunities to foster their current talents and develop new skills through programs designed to prepare them for their post-secondary plans. Students are encouraged to participate across a range of offerings that are; creative endeavors, athletic pursuits, intellectual interests, and passion projects. 
