MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Panyaden International School opened its doors in 2011. Years 7 to 9 were added in 2018 and our first graduating class was the Class of 2023. Panyaden has a highly qualified and experienced international faculty with a strong commitment to education and passion for their subject areas. We aim to foster students' intellectual, physical, social, and emotional development through a combination of rigorous courses, and wider curricular and co-curricular opportunities.

Academic Programmes

Students attend six 55-minute period classes per day split into two equal terms.

Year 10 and 11 students:

- Take 10 courses across a broad range of disciplines.
- Follow an internally designed CAS programme that includes the completion of the Duke of Edinburgh's International Award.

Year 12 and 13 students:

- Have the option to enroll in the full International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme or in a combination of IB courses and High School courses.
- Complete Theory of Knowledge, Creative, Activity, Service, and Extended Essay or Research Project requirements.

Graduation Pathways and Requirements

All students work towards the WASC-accredited Panyaden High School Diploma. Students might choose to enroll in the IB Diploma Programme or select IB Courses. To graduate, a student must acquire a minimum number of 38 credits across seven different subject areas.

- 1 credit is earned per one-term course.
- To attain credit for a course a student must end the course with a final grade of 3 or higher out of 7.
- When a student transfers, credits and course load from a previous school will be reviewed to ensure alignment with graduation requirements.

Assessment, Grading, and Reporting

- Assessment is based on a 1 to 7 scale, following the IB grade descriptors.
- Panyaden does not rank students nor calculate grade point average.
- Achievement grade reports are twice per year, in December and June.

Wider Curriculum

- Students in Years 10 to 13 meet every day in small groups with their faculty advisor to build a strong community.
- Our wider curriculum offers a diverse and inclusive co-curricular programme in over 40 clubs and activities. Activities such as Model United Nations participate in regional and national events.
- Panyaden offers 3 sports seasons, including 9 sports, and participates in a competitive league formed by international schools in Chiang Mai (CMAC).
